Review the advantages of using a business entity to hold land over individual ownership. Income and estate tax implications will be discussed in more detail including discounted gifting. Six separate types of entities will

be discussed leading to a conclusion of the best entity for land ownership and ending with precautions when using business entities, especially the IRS mainly successful attempts to include transferred business assets in the estate of a decedent under Section 2036 (retained interest).

Utilizing Intensive Forest Management

Techniques presented will include Wildlife Stand Improvement, Native Plant Enhancement, Interspersion Index Features, Stalking Lanes, Elevational Food Plots, Three-Feature Hunting Designs, Nutritional Anchor Food Plots, Supplemental Feeding/Minerals, Ecotone Installation, Travel/Feeding Lane Management, and Internal Sanctuaries. Whitetail Deer Herd Management will also be addressed including Camera Census Methodology (buck:doe ratio, buck age structure, fawning percentage, twinning percentage, antler morphology, herd health), Quality Deer Management, Carrying Capacity, Predator Control, Buck Aging, and Harvest Strategies.
